

**Brief Report on Day Camp @ Saeedabad District Matiari**

Date: September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2010

Time: 10:00am to 2:30pm

A one day mobile health camp for internally displaced women and children affected by flood/rain was arranged by Department of Paediatrics & Child Health Aga Khan University, in collaboration with District Health Management Matiari, Taluka Saeedabad on September 2<sup>nd</sup> 2010. During the day, the team visited three fixed camps located in the remote sites and provided free consultation, counseling, and medications to the affected population.
